

Countries disseminate useful and up-to-date information to public on national news portals which include Ministries' website, social networks, TV and Information Education Communication (IEC) materials.

The MBDS (Mekong Basin Disease Surveillance) cooperation is a self-organized sub-regional network commenced since 2001. It is a collaboration effort among six Mekong Basin countries such as Cambodia, China, Lao P.D.R, Myanmar, Thailand and Vietnam. It aims to strengthen national and sub-regional capabilities in infectious disease surveillance and outbreak response, especially on 18 currently designated priority diseases including Ebola, MERS, Zika, Malaria and Dengue to


reflecting country cumulative case counts, as of February 3, 2020


