Antimicrobial resistance (AMR) is a major public health concern globally and emerging in low- and middle-income countries.

The One Health approach has been used to develop a protocol of AMR surveillance in Ghana involving multi-sectoral collaboration. Non-typhoid *Salmonella*, *Klebsiella pneumoniae*, and other gram-negative bacteria isolated from human, animal and environmental sources were the target pathogens assessed for AMR. The results of the pilot evaluation of this protocol will be presented and discussed.
